

TIMETABLE OF BUSES

From Rome to Avellino

The buses from Avellino to Rome (Tiburtina station) are run by two companies: [Caputo bus](#) and [Flixbus](#). They leave from Tiburtina railway station, in Rome¹, and arrive at different stations at Avellino; the only exception is the 18 bus, that will take you to Montella directly, with no intermediate stops.

On Tuesday, June the 24th the following buses are scheduled (the times indicated on the left refer to departure from Tiburtina station):

9 (Flixbus): arrival at Avellino at 12:05;

9:55 (Flixbus): arrival at Avellino at 13:45;

16:15 (Flixbus): arrival at Avellino at 19:05;

17:40 (Flixbus): arrival at Avellino at 20:55;

18 (Caputo bus): arrival at Montella, 21:40.

The timetable of [Flixbus](#) is often changed: please consult their website.

The cost of the ticket varies from 15 to 30 euros.

From Avellino to Rome

The buses from Avellino to Rome (Tiburtina station) are run by the same two companies: [Caputo bus](#) and [Flixbus](#).

On Wednesday, July the 2nd the following buses are scheduled:

8:30 (Caputo bus): departure from Montella; arrival at Rome (Tiburtina station) at 12:30;

15:30 (Flixbus): departure from Avellino; arrival at Rome at 18:35.

The timetable of [Flixbus](#) is often changed: please consult their website.

The cost of the ticket varies from 15 to 35 euros.

From Naples Capodichino airport to Avellino, and the other way around

There are 23 buses from Naples Capodichino airport (terminal 2) to Avellino every day. They are all run by [Air](#).

The bus stop is in [via Oreste Salomone](#), 46: about 500 metres from the airport exit.

On June the 24th, the first bus will leave at 5:47, and the last at 20:38. The trip will last about an hour.

There are 18 buses from Avellino to Naples airport every day.

On July the 2nd, the first bus will leave at 6:40, and the last at 21:30. The trip will last about an hour.

The ticket costs about 7 euros. (You can buy it on board, with a little supplement.)

¹ Participants who arrive at the “Leonardo da Vinci” Fiumicino airport can get to Tiburtina station by train. There are many trains, and trips last about three quarters of an hour. The ticket costs 10 euros. If you disembark at Ciampino (which is the other Rome airport), you can catch one of the many shuttle buses, and, again, you will arrive at the Tiburtina station in approximately three quarters of an hour. The ticket costs 7 or 8 euros.



From Avellino to Montella, and the other way round

There are 4 buses from Avellino to Montella every day. They are all run by [Air](#):

12:31: arrival at Montella at 13:19;
14: arrival at Montella at 15:01;
17:50: arrival at Montella at 19:10;
20:10: arrival at Montella at 21:00.

There are 4 buses every day from Montella to Avellino too:

7:20: arrival at Avellino at 8:25;
8:14: arrival at Avellino at 9:21;
14:34: arrival at Avellino at 15:59;
18:26: arrival at Avellino at 19:14.

The ticket costs about 3 euros. (You can buy it on board, with a little supplement.)

If you like, we can send a car to Avellino (or to Naples) to pick you up. If a sufficient number of participants asks for it, we can even rent a private bus, that would take you of Montella. The cost of this service, which is not included in the booking packages, will vary from 15 to 25 euros per person.

The same services (a car or a private bus, from Montella to Avellino or to Naples) will be available on July the 2nd too. The cost will be the same (from 15 to 25 euros per person).
